

THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to All!

This weekend we will celebrate the third RCIA rite of scrutiny at the Noon Mass. The 20 collective individuals from the RCIA and RCIC programs bring great blessing to our community. Let us continue to hold these individuals in prayer during these weeks that lead to their reception. This week they will ritually receive the Lord's Prayer, a sign of their relationship to God and our community of faith that embraces them. This Friday the Confirmandi went to visit the L'Arch community. It was a deeply enriching experience for them and for all who attended this retreat. These enthusiastic young Christians are a great sign of hope for the Church. We are praying that we will soon be able to develop a youth outreach ministry for the parish in the coming year. Please pray for this important ministry. If you are interested in becoming involved in this, please approach me or Sheila Malloch to talk about it.

The communication committee met last week with the individuals involved with the company that does pictorial parish directories. We are looking to engage individuals who would be interested in helping with this project for a couple of weeks in May or June. The work and plans for developing the hall, the storage facilities, making repairs, seeing the electrical work done, and several other projects are all under way. Perhaps the most immediate projects that we will see realized are on the weekend of May 7 when the parish volunteers will come together for a cleanup, paint up, fix up day. We are deeply grateful for the very dedicated and professional work and service that is given to the parish through the Building Maintenance Committee. May God bless the work of their hands.

Next week is Palm Sunday. We will begin the celebration in the hall with the blessing of the palms and process around to the Church. Palm Sunday or Passion Sunday is the day we remember the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem to begin the Holy Week celebrations. The details of our schedules are posted in the bulletin. We hope you will be able to participate in these most holy celebrations especially the Triduum liturgies of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil.

The parish reconciliation service will be held on Friday evening April 15. Several priests will be here at 7:30 for the celebration. One other service that was not mentioned is the diocesan Chrism Mass held at St. Michael's Cathedral on Tuesday April 19 at 11:00 AM. This is the liturgy at which the holy oils used throughout the year are blessed by the Archbishop. It is also a time when the priests of the Archdiocese renew their priestly commitment. Anyone interested is welcome to attend.

We are confident that the Lord will continue to bless us as a parish in this Most Holy Season and may he bless each of our households with Grace and Love.
