Happy Easter! He is truly risen, Alleluia! It was a beautiful Holy Week here at St. Joan of Arc even with the restrictions in place. I heard from Fr. Our numbers were down but it was far greater than last year with just Fr. Ken and me. Hopefully next year we will be filled. We added a Blessing of Easter Foods on Holy Saturday. I was thrilled at the number of computers online – almost 300! Multiply it by the number of viewers at each computer and that is a terrific number for a first-time event. Next year I hope to see all the foods brought in to church, [and hopefully have a little left behind ©].

Our online numbers have continued to climb, and we will continue to stream Masses and services online. I would like to get a committee together to run the technical side of these. If any of you know a tech savvy person willing to donate some time, have them reach out to me. It's not that difficult to do – right now I run the live-stream, play the music, control the camera, and celebrate Mass at the same time. Having at least one person to handle the technical end of things on a rotating basis would be great.

I want to profoundly thank all those who helped us celebrate Holy Week, we couldn't have done it without them. Remember, when the restrictions are over, we will need even more volunteers to keep the parish alive. I'm not sure if we will ever get back to our former Mass schedule, but I envision a lively and active parish! As a stewardship parish you are not "volunteers" but "ministers" in and for the parish. Every member of the congregation should be asking themselves "What is God calling me to do in the parish?"

It was a tiring week for sure. Because of the pandemic I had to do a lot of things on my own hauling all the flowers into the church, decorating, setting up for each service, and then running the services reminded me of how, even before COVID, I was hoping to start up an Environment and Art Committee in the parish and training them for the role to take over, in a formal sense, the décor of the parish for the Church year. So be thinking of this - so that when we can meet face-to-face, we can get it up and running.

I know the news looks bleak with a possibility of another wave of infections, but I encourage you to get your shots so that we can be together sooner rather than later. Be on the lookout for our new website which should be up and running very soon! My thanks to the Stewardship Committee for all the time and effort they have put into it. I encourage you to download the MyParish app for your phones. It enables us to immediately reach out to you, it lets groups communicate with each other, and it provides handy information to you.
