

We continue to celebrate the new life of Easter throughout the parish as we prepare our children and young people who will be receiving First Communion next Sunday and Confirmations later in the month of May. Please keep these young people and their families in your prayers. The newly baptized and received members of the RCIA will participate in an archdiocesan celebration at the Cathedral with the Cardinal next Wednesday. The ongoing period of Mystagogy for these new members of our parish is one that encourages their growth and incorporation into the full life of the Church, and this event helps them to recognize their participation in the universality of their ongoing journey in faith.

This past Tuesday the finance committee met to finalize the annual parish report. This will be attached to the bulletin in the coming weeks when a member of the committee will give a brief synopsis and invite any discussion you might have following the masses. The AGM in June will also provide opportunity to review the report for the parish community.

The parish ministries committee also met on Tuesday to continue in the process of clarifying our parish mission, vision and identifying our ministerial needs as we serve the community. A parish survey tool is being developed to give us feedback from the whole parish and help us recognize the direction and needs that you may have to assist in the growth and development of our parish life and ministry. This survey will be placed in the pews in a few weeks and collected in the back of the church after the masses. Thank you for your participation in this process.

Share Life continues in these coming weeks. So far we have reached over half the goal, and we are confident that this year we will surpass it. There is a matching grant for any new or increased contributions to this effort. Share life is the chief driver for Archdiocesan Charitable and Social outreach. Thank you for your generous contributions to these causes.

At the zone meeting today the parish ministers gathered to discuss the diocesan resources available for religious education of children and adults, it is our hope to continue in the work of building the faith of our community and continuing the evangelical mission of the Church that we are called to realize. We are always seeking individuals who are interested in becoming catechists, RCIA sponsors or adult educators so that we may enrich the growth of our faith community. Thank you to all who participate in these efforts and we welcome new participants to these efforts.

Thank you again to all for your participation in the stewardship of our parish. May the Risen Lord, breath the Holy Spirit upon us to continue the life and mission He has given us to realize by our faith in God.
