# The Pastor's Corner Peace and Goodness to All!

As the Easter Season draws ever closer to the celebration of Pentecost, we remember the command of Jesus given to his first apostles, "Love one another as I have loved you." This commandment is foundational to the Church which gathers each week to remember the words and works of Jesus that are the life giving examples of how we are to fulfill His command in our own life and time. This week our parish celebrated the sacrament of First Eucharist for our children whose parents and teachers have instilled in them the meaning of this love by the word and example in their family lives as the gospel informs us and forms us as a Church. It has been a joy to witness the love and dedication of the parents and teachers of our First Communicants in the weeks and months that lead to this joyful day. Every time we gather as a Church for Sunday Eucharist we remember the life giving sacrifice of Love that Jesus gave us to free us from our sins and to demonstrate the love we are to have for one another. What a grace filled and beautiful time of year it is for our parish to celebrate these wonderful sacraments at this time. It is a testament to the faith being carried to yet another generation of faith filled Christians. The Confirmation class is supported by dedicated parents, teachers and sponsors whose Christian witness and teaching transmit our Faith in Christ with an authority that is important and powerful in the lives of the Confirmandi.
