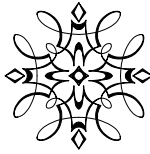

This will cut Facebook out as a middleman and hopefully make our task of live streaming things run more smoothly.

I say hopefully because as you know we have always had technical glitches and I imagine there may be some as we make this transition but stick with us, together we'll get through it. I appreciate your patience with me during the times when we've had difficulties with sound and difficulties with picture. Your responses have always been very kind. Maybe someday we'll get together a Tech ministry of people who know what they're doing to handle this.

One thing I hope you will see is a lot more pictures of things going on at Saint Joan of Arc. Of course, we need to get things happening again so that we can take current pictures, but I am confident that we are moving in that direction and as we do so I hope to draw more families to the parish. (When they see how much fun we have!)

We are also looking to set up a date for Spring Cleaning. With the effects of COVID on the wane I would hope that we get a bunch of people to help us outside the church, around the grounds, and maybe even inside the church. Last year we only had one person sign up to help. So, a lot didn't get done. And given the situation over the last couple of years, there are a lot of things that need sprucing up. I hope to see lots of people sign up. I'm even willing to spring for Timbits© for the occasion!
