THE PASTOR'S CORNER <u>PEACE AND ALL GOODNESS!</u>

Tuesday night after the meetings were finished I caught a late showing of a movie called: "Of Gods and Men" (Des homes et des dieux) This is a French movie in English subtitles. It tells the true story about the Tibhrine community of Trappist Monks who were located in Algeria during the late 1990s, and who were killed by a radical group of terrorists even as they served the local muslim community among whom they lived and worked. The film premiered at the 2010 Cannes Film Festival where it won the Grand Prix, the festival's second most prestigious award. This movie has received both critical acclaim and market success throughout the world. I rarely go to the movies, and even remember when in our family movies were forbidden during lent. Last month as many of you know, I spent a couple of days with the Atonement Friars at meetings in Vancouver where the friars were all talking about this wonderful movie. Well it certainly did not disappoint. The clear gospel message that is demonstrated in this film and the way that several of the monks were martyred portray a modern depiction of the Passion and love of the Lord Jesus Christ poured out for all people. The interfaith message of our faith is beautifully illustrated in this production. The meaning of the incarnation and saving mission of Jesus is poignantly displayed by the lives of these monks and I hope many of you may have an opportunity to go and see this film. It is well worth the time and effort it may take to go downtown to see it.

Tuesday evening the families of our students to be confirmed came together to meet one another and to engage in a bit of a program for community building. We are deeply grateful for the dedication of all of our parents and families who dedicate their time and attention to the preparation of our children to receive the sacraments. Whether it is confirmation, first reconciliation or first communion, our parents are deeply committed to their children and our Church. May God Bless them, and let us all pray for these young people and their families in this time of faith formation. This weekend the Confirmandi will attend the L'Arche retreat, Sheila Malloch is to be commended for her outreach in this endeavour.

At our staff meeting this week we began discussing the possibility of producing a parish pictorial directory. Many of you remember that this was done six or seven years ago, so it is time to update it. It is our hope to begin the process in May so that we will have the finished product in the summer or early autumn. This would be a great help to building parish community, and we will be rolling out more details in the coming weeks.

As we come to the last three weeks in Lent, let us continue to pray for the Church throughout the world, that we may be renewed in Faith Hope and Love. Let us pray for our parish that we may grow to serve the mission of the Lord. Last weekend we held a retreat for all who are engaged in our liturgical ministries. During this time we presented the group with the beginning tools to focus on the meaning of our parish mission and to clarify a mission statement that would express the richness of who we are as St. Joan of Arc Parish. This effort is a way of continuing the good work that we began last Advent and that we will continue as we prepare to celebrate the Paschal mysteries in Passion Week and Easter. It will take perhaps a year for us to complete a mission statement. This will proceed to be a work of the Parish Council and the various parish committees and organizations. Let us thank God for the many ways he blesses us to be a dynamic parish engaged in the Mission of Our Lord.

2010 Shepherd's Trust

The Archdiocese has informed us that our results for the Shepherd's Trust collection in 2010 had decreased from the previous year. In 2009 we collected \$3,810.00, and in 2010 we collected \$1,670.00.

The Archdiocesan numbers are up 1.5%. In 2009 they received \$1,497,083 and in 2010 \$1,518,935.00. This is dependant, upon their Investment Income. The overall Fund balance is \$35,000,000.00.
