The Lord is Risen as He said, Alleluia, Alleluia!

Welcome to St. Joan of Arc Church for the great celebration of Easter. Jesus the Resurrection and the Life is our surest hope. He has risen from death, our greatest fear to show us the salvation he has won for us and for all creation! God so loved the world that he sent his only Son to show us the way to life in its fullness. As a parish we are blessed to hear, to live and to proclaim this gospel of new life that we celebrate most gloriously in this holy season. 
