### The Pastor's Corner

Peace and Goodness to all!

This fifth week of Lent was called Passion Sunday, which led the Passiontide or two weeks before Easter when the tone of the period was somber and severe. The removal or covering of the statuary were external observances viewed as signs of penitential preparations for Easter. While we continue to change the décor to some extent, the focus is more on reconciliation and preparation for the sacraments of initiation which we are celebrating as a community and that reach its climax in liturgy at the Easter Vigil.

This week on Wednesday, we celebrated the parish communal reconciliation service which helps us to prepare ourselves to be open and attentive to the saving action of God in this holy time. On Sunday the RCIA candidates will celebrate the third and final Scrutiny at the 7:00 PM mass, which will focus on the enlightenment that is brought to us in Jesus the Resurrection and the Life who raised Lazarus from the dead, and who motivates us to live for Christ in our life circumstances.

Our confirmation class, of 2014, continues to prepare to celebrate their reception of the Holy Spirit in this wonderful sacrament. The young people in our parish are an inspiration to me and to all of us as they demonstrate their growth in Spirit and Faith each week. Their presentation of the Spirit Movers from L'Arche brought a great blessing to our parish last week. This class also brings life and vitality to our growing youth group which has re-named itself: "Youth to the World". This past Friday evening they held a games night. They are now contemplating a fundraising event to support the needs of youth in Honduras that were brought to their attention by one of their members.

Next week, we will be celebrating our Lenten Soup night where all are invited to bring the alms collected throughout the Lenten fasting to feed the hungry who attend the Winter Welcome Table throughout the colder months. It is a great way to bring our Lenten fasting to fruition.

As we walk together in these final weeks of our Lenten Journey, let us pray that the Lord will continue to guide us in the footsteps of Jesus through the passion and death of the Lord to his Glorious Resurrection and the Newness of Life it will bring.

#### ShareLife: Working wonders for Children with special needs..

We have always tried to expose our deaf children to both communities. As their parents, we have talked to them and tried to answer their questions when they saw someone using sign language and they had basic sign language books. Then one day our oldest son, Ethan, said he would like to learn sign language. We discovered Silent Voice's Sign Language summer Camp and enrolled him in the programme. The following year Gavin joined his older brother and they both want to go again. We also put our name in for the Family Communication program because we wanted to support our children. These opportunities increased the boys' awareness of the deaf community and also helped them gain respect for different ways of communication. They enjoyed both experiences as did we. We all hope to take part in the Family programme again. Last year more than 600 deaf children received support thorough Silent Voice's Sign Language Summer Camps.
