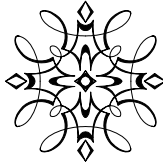

The Pastor's Corner

Peace and goodness to All!

Greetings from Mont Tremblant, Quebec. This morning, I left the two and 1/2 days of meetings at Graymoor of the Atonement Friar General Council meetings around 11:30 am, and arrived here at about 7:00 pm. It was great to be with the friars and continue our business. Fr. Brian Terry, the general said he would give us a date when he will come and visit us in the coming months. Many of you remember when he was here at St Joan of Arc parish after he was first ordained about 16 years ago We talked about bringing our youth group up to Graymoor for a special gathering next summer. That would be great fun for them and an opportunity to have a youth gathering in the beautiful Hudson Valley setting that situates Graymoor. More on this as things develop, so stay tuned.

There was a driving rain all the way up on the drive here and the brightest part of the day came around 6:00 PM when the Sun appeared through the clouds. Being an optimist I searched for the rainbow, but thought better to pay attention to the road. After shopping for breakfast foods, and other staples for the next couple of days, I finally settled in around 8:15 pm, then headed out to a nice dinner. Tomorrow night I will cook on the grill from the hotel deck. it was enough this evening to get here and get settled. My bike and other triathlon accessories are now all in the room and tomorrow I will register for the race and get my bearings. I told him I would be celebrating mass at the St Bernard chapel in Mont Tremblant after the interfaith ceremony and he would be welcome to join us. Last year we were in the church yard because they had to lock it up after the interfaith service, so we'll see what happens this year. He said he would have about 25 of his fellow Filipino brothers with him again and he would be sure to round them up for the occasion. I will try to remember my cell phone to get a photo. Last time there were close to a hundred who stayed for the mass. It is a small world.

Right now the moon is peeking through the trees that have already started to turn color here in the Laurentian Mts., I am getting ready to turn it in for the night but wanted to get this article in before the deadline tomorrow morning. . The athletes were all gathering today, but tomorrow and Friday will bring the majority in for the race on Sunday. Thank you all for your prayers and support in this venture. With the help of God I will bring back the medal to show you next Sunday. Have a good week and be sure of my love and prayers for all of you.
