

THE PASTOR'S CORNER Peace and Goodness to all!

The second reading today taken from Hebrews: Ch. 12, vs. 1-4 depicts the great crowd of witnesses of saints who await our final life destination in heaven. This vision has been prefigured for me and others in the thousands of people who gather at the end of the Ironman venues to encourage the racers at the finish line. It is a marvellous experience to see so many who have finished the race themselves and the family members of the racers enthusiastically cheering those who approach the finish line throughout the evening hours. God willing this will be the 18th Ironman finish line for me to cross, at whatever time. I hope then I will to join the others to greet those who come after me. What a great experience this is. This is my first Ironman race at Mont Tremblant in Canada, and so it has special significance for me as a recent permanent resident in Canada. Thank you so much for your love and prayerful support.

When St. Paul used this analogy to help us to understand how we are joined with the saints in heaven who have gone before us, he helped us to see what it means to be a Church united with Christ as one communion with all who are baptized into the life death and resurrection of Jesus the Lord. This annual race has been for me a way to reconnect with friends and it inspires me to sustain physical fitness throughout the year. St. Paul inspires us to maintain our relationship with the Lord, at all times and to sustain our relationships with one another in the most important journey we share in the life of the Church. We have so many friends and relatives who have gone before us in the faith journey waiting for us to cross the line to be with them in the Lord for all eternity. The struggles we share in life unite us to Christ himself in his life death and resurrection so as St. Paul says, "let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of faith, who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the Cross disregarding its shame and has taken his seat and the right hand of the Throne of God."

Thank you all for your prayers for me on this day, and always, these will sustain and inspire me throughout the hours of the race and will help me to be united with all of the racers today, and with you always, in the journey of life that is ours united in faith hope and love with Christ our Victor and Lord.
