It is the morning after the Ironman race in Lake Placid, thank God I feel fine, even if the stairs are felt on the climb. I am at High Peak's Cycle Store where my friends the Delaneys are letting me use their Wifi. Brian Delaney ran the race with me yesterday and like all the athletes we're looking forward to some great hamburgers tonight for supper. No doubt Rosanne has already posted my times in the bulletin, it was a good race even if it was a little warm and humid. Saturday night I celebrated the "Iron-Mass" at St Agnes' Church in Lake Placid. The Church was overflowing its capacity and it was great to see so many old friends and acquaintances gathered to celebrate. Fr. John, the pastor then called all the athletes forward to be with me at the Altar where he blessed us for the race. There were a couple of hundred athletes crowded up there, and as ever was quite moving. All along the race people called out to "Iron Friar" and said thank you for the mass the night before. This morning, I will go over to visit one of our friars, Brother Pascal in the nursing home to show him the medal and to share some laughter and a visit before the noon mass. The Sisters of Mercy who provide pastoral care are long-time friends and it is always a joy to come back here to visit. Tomorrow evening, I will start my drive back up to Toronto and so will be there for Mass on Wednesday. It will be fun to show you all the medal on Sunday. Thank you to all of you who supported the Iron Friar for ShareLife this year. Your generosity to care for the most vulnerable is an inspiration. Thank you also for your prayerful support at the Masses on Sunday, they were felt deeply and appreciated very much. This was the 20th Ironman race that I have done in 19 years.
