The Pastor's Corner *Peace and Goodness to All!*

Mont Tremblant is a beautiful part of Quebec, and a marvelous venue for the Ironman Race. The evening before the race there is a blessing of the athletes which I participated in last year, at the Chapel of St. Bernard. It is a lovely and historic little place on the shore of Lake Tremblant. Last year after the blessing I celebrated mass outside the chapel for about a hundred who stayed because the Chapel was locked after the blessing. The chapel was locked this year even before the blessing, and the rain was constant so I arranged to have some of the vendors to lend me their tents and we put three together for the blessing of a couple of hundred athletes and their families. Then I celebrated mass for those who wanted to stay. It was a cozy gathering that prepared us with the Bread of Life for the Journey. This lent itself to appreciating the many volunteers who stand along the 226 kilometer racecourse handing out food and water to sustain the athletes on the race. The hand of God feeds us always, and to see the generous care that is given by the volunteers for the athletes is analogous to the sustenance that God gives us every day as we receive our "daily bread".

The morning of the race it was cold and rainy, but after the 3.6k swim, the weather cleared as we began the 180 k bike course. It was familiar territory for me, and I was doing fine until just before a very steep climb for the last 80k, the gear cable for my rear detailer broke leaving me in the most difficult ring of the gears. I struggled to the top of the mountain where there was an aid station, wondering if it would be possible to finish the race on the bike as it was by the cut off time. I was advised that it would be best to call a technician and wait for him to repair the bike, so I wouldn't hurt myself, so I got off the bike and waited. It was an opportunity to pass out water and bananas to the riders as they went by. An opportunity to be a part of those feeding the athletes along the way. Finally the repair man came along, switched out the broken cable and had me on my way, biking as fast as I could to make it back before the 5:30 PM cut off time. The last part of the race is very hilly, and challenging, but I came in with 15 minutes to spare and started the 42.2k run. The run was great fun because many recognized me with the "Iron Friar" tee shirt that I have worn for 19 races. Many of those who had participated in the prayer service and Mass greeted and thanked me along the way. As it grew dark, I put on my hiker's headlamp and moved forward toward the finish line. It was the best marathon time I have recorded since I was pushing to make up for the time lost on the bike.

At the finish line I was greeted by Mike Riley, "the voice of Ironman" with "Father Dan, you are an Ironman". What a thrill it is to see all the folks in the grandstand cheering on the racers until the midnight cut off time. I finished at 11:16 so there was some time to watch the others come in. They gave out gold medals shaped like a gear this year and given my difficulties, I felt personally that it was appropriate and I had earned it. Altogether it was a great race and I felt the prayers and support of everyone in the parish all along the way. Thank you for your love and support for the Iron Friar. After a day of rest and a very nice dinner I was ready to return on Tuesday. It is great to be back with you all today, thank you again for your love and prayers
