



# THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to all!

"I am the Bread of Life" Jesus assures us, whoever comes to him will never hunger or thirst. The sacramental presence of the Lord in Eucharist is the source and summit of our life as a Church, and is realized in all of our work and ministry. In the Archdiocese much of the work and ministry to care for the poor is accomplished through the Share Life Campaign that is held each year. Every parish is given a goal to contribute to this campaign. Ours this year was \$57,000. At the July 31 tally we were at \$58,331 so I am proud and pleased to tell you we have surpassed our goal through your generosity to this campaign.

Thank you all for your contributions to this important effort to care for those who turn to the Church to meet their material and spiritual needs through various Archdiocesan programs. I am deeply grateful to all of you for your generosity. Thank you once again.

This afternoon, after the morning masses, I will leave for New York to stay at the Atonement Friary there and get ready for the Ironman Race next Saturday on the feast of St. Clare. This will consist of a 3.8k swim in the Hudson River, 180k bike ride on the Palisades Parkway in NJ. and NY, then a 42.2 run that goes over the George Washington bridge and finishes in Riverside Park at W. 83<sup>rd</sup>. Street in Manhattan. Thank you for your prayers for me in this effort. Upon completion of this race, I will be eligible to run the Ironman race in Hawaii, and so we have combined the Iron Friar Campaign this year to include the two races. The benefit of the Campaign this year will be to purchase and install a retractable stage for the parish hall. In previous years we installed the Church bells, the new signs for the Church and have repaired the stained glass windows that had been broken for some years. I needed to make this clear, so that you realize that the funds we raise are not to pay my expenses on these races. The ticket for the trip to Hawaii, was paid for by the gift the parish gave me when I celebrated my 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of ordination back in January, so you all did indeed make it possible for me to do that race.

Thank you for your prayers as I engage in the race in NY on Saturday. May the Lord send us favorable weather for the race. I will return here on Tuesday Aug 14 and I hope to present a medal the following Sunday at the Masses as in previous years. Fr. Pat Cogan SA whom most of you know, will be here during my holidays please welcome him back. I am very grateful that he will be with us.

Thank you again everyone for your prayerful support, and I will see you in two weeks.
