I've been having lots of meetings these past few weeks with various groups in the parish. We are working toward getting the parish up and running post-Covid. In the new year, hopefully you will notice some changes. All of our liturgical ministries will be scheduled online and available on our website. We have already moved the live stream Sunday Mass to the website and are continuing to tweak that. We are getting back to social functions like Sunday coffee and Merrymakers. We can now take debit cards as a source of payment both in the office and on free trade Sundays. We are looking at modernizing a few of the things around the parish in hopes of communicating better and drawing more people to the church.

I know that some of you have been waiting for us to bring back additional Masses and after a meeting last week I've decided to try bringing back the 12 noon Mass for Lent. If we find enough people attending, we will keep that back in the schedule. If not, we will stop it again at Easter. We certainly have enough parishioners to populate an additional Mass so I'm hoping that we get more people coming back once the 12:00 o'clock Mass is reinstated.

It has been difficult getting all of our ministries back up and running due to the fact that for some of them we have no one who wants to be the contact person. This is especially true for the altar servers and for the greeters/ ushers. You'll notice that we combined the ministry of greeter and usher because they overlap and since we have no one to coordinate them that means we have one less person needed for the ministry. As I said before the scheduling of these ministries will all be done online so the coordinator doesn't have to make up schedules, they simply need to schedule training for the ministries, and be a contact person. If you think you might be up to it, I would welcome hearing from you! It would be like an early Christmas present!

I would like to think all the many parishioners who are working behind the scenes to keep the parish moving forward and looking ahead. I hope they never tire.
