



THE PASTOR'S CORNER

This the last Sunday in Advent the Church remembers St. Joseph and his role as the wife of Mary. He was instructed to name her son Jesus, miraculously conceived by the Holy Spirit. Joseph's received his message from an angel in a dream, and obeyed it. As the story unfolds we see that he is also attentive to the laws of the land as he directs his family to go to Bethlehem where the Child will be born. He listens to the political news of the times that will protect the safety of his family and later we see he is obedient to the religious directives of their Jewish faith as Jesus is presented in the temple. We know few details of this just man but what is clearly evident is his openness to life and reality as it presents itself to him. His willingness to act in prudence and wisdom make him a model for parents of all time as an ideal husband and father.

Last week the priests of the Archdiocese gathered for a day of prayer and recollection to prepare us for the many worship services that we will serve over these days. I was one of the 5 priests privileged to be asked to hear confessions during this retreat. It was simply inspiring to participate in this sacrament which we will provide to our parishioners in preparation for Christmas. The sacrament of reconciliation is a humbling experience for me, whether receiving the sacrament or administering it. How beautifully this prepared me for the coming celebrations. Christmas is the celebration of the humility of God; who humbled himself to become one with us in the humanity of the child; named and protected by St. Joseph the just and humble head of the Holy Family. May this last week of Advent prepare us all to receive Him in our hearts.

May the love and Joy of Christ fill your life in this season of Grace.
