Dear Friends and Family in Christ:

It is difficult to say goodbye to my beloved parishioners, but God is calling me to a new life and responsibility where I will be a pastor to the Friars and employees of the Franciscan Friars of the Atonement who serve at Graymoor. New beginnings for the New Year! Please know you are always in my heart and my prayers, and I thank you for your love and friendship in this holy time of year.
