A Little Housekeeping is required!

As reported at the Mini AGM, I would like to remind everyone that this is your parish! We have to look after our church building, that means **turning off lights** and **locking doors** when we are leaving the building. For example: our last hydro bill was \$1,630.18 for one month, because lights are left on all night! This is only one bill. The heating bill is just as bad.

In general, do what you would do before leaving your home. When we use items in the kitchen, we are responsible to **wash**, **dry and put away** the items. We must not leave items out on the counter. Please do not leave food in the kitchen. When in the kitchen, please read all the notices that have been posted. We have and endless battle going on trying to get rid of all the little critters! Please help us!

When leaving the building **Push the doors closed**, as they do not always close by themselves, in fact, they some times are open all night. Then the next day people walk in on the parish staff startling them, as they are coming in from an unexpected direction. Please look around before you leave the building and help us look after our church building and save some money.
