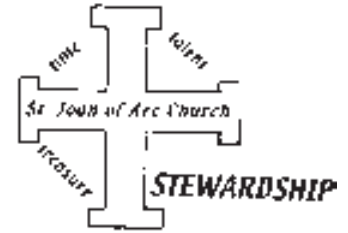

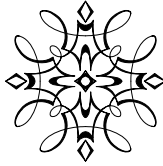

Marriage Enrichment Feb. 25-27

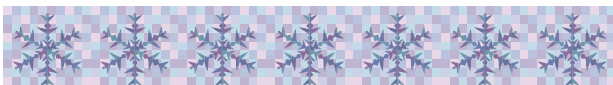
