

#### THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to All!

Here we are at Mardi Gras, or Carnival, in the last few days before the Lenten Season begins. Mardi Gras of course is translated "Fat Tuesday", and Carnival derives from Latin words meaning, "Farewell to Meat". Mardi Gras and Carnival celebrations held throughout the western Christian world are a way to celebrate with a bit of excess before the season of fasting, prayer and abstinence that characterize the discipline of lent.

"Paczek" or Punchki, a big fat jelly donut is eaten on Fat Tuesday by the polish people, and anyone else who has discovered these decadent treats. Fastnachts eaten by Germans and Swiss are a similar treat with lots of fat and calories to eat and celebrate before the Lenten fast. What fun it is that so many cultures enjoy festive ways to get ready for the holy Lenten season. Here at St. Joan of Arc, on Fat Tuesday night, the Confirmation class will host a Pancake and Sausage feast to get us ready.

This Wednesday, Ash Wednesday, is a day of fasting and abstinence when we with the Church throughout the world will come together to receive the mark of repentance and begin our period of 40 days of prayer, fasting and almsgiving to prepare us to celebrate the Pascal Feasts and Easter. This is a joyful time for all of us to once again reflect on our lives as we walk in the desert with Jesus, to reflect on ways we can conform our attitudes and behaviors to become like Him.

"Remember that thou art dust and unto dust thou shall return" was the traditional word that accompanied the imposition of ashes. Now "Repent and Conform to the Gospel" is more commonly recited to remind us that we are called together in this time of Lent to be faithful to our Christian way of life. People all over the city and all over the world will receive the sign of our repentance so we can once again realize that we are walking together with the whole Church in the hope of conversion and new life.

Throughout the seven weeks of lent our Scripture readings will help us to deeply reflect on our call. Many people adopt the practice of daily mass throughout the Lenten season and many will adopt penitential forms of prayer and fasting to help them to remain focused on the Lord throughout this time. Let us pray together that each of us individually, and that we as a parish may grow in holiness and grace in this Lenten time so that our appreciation of the Pascal Mystery may grow ever deeper in the Love of our Risen Lord at Easter Time.

#### **Ash Wednesday February 22**

This is one of the two days in the church year (the other is Good Friday) when healthy persons between the ages of 18 and 59 are asked to observe a day of fast and abstinence. This consists of having one full meal (with no meat) and up to two other meals which, taken together, do not equal the full meal; no snacks in between and no meat at any meal. We are asked to be sensible with regard to specific conditions. A construction worker, a person with diabetes or a nursing mother would not be expected to rigidly follow this precept. Observance of it is the church's way of helping us to be aware that we are entering a time of a more sombre preparation of our hearts for the full celebration of the Paschal Mystery at Easter. Abstinence on the other Fridays of Lent is a matter of personal, voluntary discipline, recommended but not required by church precept. If we are not abstaining, we should be replacing it with some other personal discipline.
