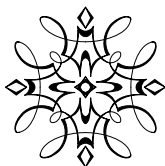

We can only accomplish this by considering God's love poured out in the forgiving act of redemption that Jesus Christ accomplished by his Cross and Resurrection. As we approach Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent on March 5th, we ask God to bless us as we prepare for the Holy Season and celebrate the Pascal Mysteries in Holy Week and Eastertime.
