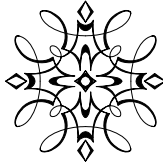

THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to all!

Our journey through the Lenten desert has begun, and now together participate in the disciplines of *prayer, fasting and almsgiving* as a way we can die to ourselves and share in the reign of God fully revealed in the death and resurrection of Christ. Prayer fasting and almsgiving work together to help us know our hunger and thirst for God. This is satisfied in prayer, and in sharing what we have with those who are in need of our excess. Prayer fasting and almsgiving work together to unite us in loving God and our neighbour as Christ has taught us.

This Sunday we focus especially on prayer as we proclaim the gospel of the Transfiguration of Jesus. In this story, the disciples share in the prayerful and mystical experience of Jesus in dialogue with Moses and Elijah. In our own worship we are brought to share this sacred presence of Christ in Eucharistic splendor. The proclamation of our faith and sharing in the Body and Blood of Christ prepare us for the journey to Jerusalem with the disciples. Together we proceed to celebrate our salvation with the Lord, most especially in Passion Week and the Easter Triduum.

Last Sunday afternoon, our catechumens and candidates gathered for reception into full communion with the Catholic Church attended the rite of election at the cathedral. Cardinal Collins signed our parish book of the elect, along with all of these books from the parishes of the Archdiocese who participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults RCIA. The rite of the elect ceremony gathered all of the RCIA elect candidates from the parishes in the Archdiocese to celebrate our shared support of these women and men who will be baptized into the death and resurrection of Christ at the Easter Vigil. Throughout the Sundays of Lent we will celebrate the rites and scrutinies at various liturgies, so the whole community can participate in the celebrations. The lectionary readings from the appropriate "A" cycle will be read in all of our parish liturgical celebrations since all, as a parish, share in the RCIA program. May the Holy Spirit guide and inspire us to appreciate this holy time so we may experience more fully the reign of God made present in Christ for all.
