



This past Tuesday we received the sad news that Bro. Kevin Goss, SA went home to the Lord. The Parish Community and the Friars of the Atonement grieve this loss with sorrow but also with mindfulness of the wonderful contributions that Brother Kevin has made to our life and ministry. His work in the parish inaugurated the Merrymaker's Monthly Mass and Luncheon which continues because of the foundation of care and joy that he laid in the creation of this ministry. Kevin was one of the founders of the Winter Welcome Table. This ministry is carried on in covenant with the Friars of the Atonement, the Sisters of Sion and the Paulist Fathers to provide a weekly dinner, fellowship and warm clothing for the less fortunate.
