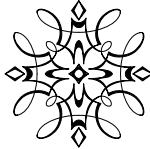

Our Parish Journeys thru' to Easter

During Lent, our Catechumens become more visible to the parish community, coming before the congregation stating that they would like to be baptized and become one with us in our faith. Another sign is the Book of Elect; last Sunday each Catechumen signed the book at the front of the church, as their way of showing that they are ready to follow the teachings of the Catholic Church.

There are three Scrutinies during Lent. Scrutinies are an outward sign of what all of us are called to do in our Lenten Renewal. These ancient rites are deeply rooted in our human experience. We also need to scrutinize those areas of our lives where we, too, need healing and strengthening, with the support of our sisters, and brothers.

Invitation to Silent Prayer: After the homily, the catechumens are called forward with their parish sponsors and invited to kneel. All of us present are invited to pray for them in a moment of silence. We have accompanied them thus far on their journey. We have sent them to reflect more deeply on the Word of God, and have expressed to them our support and our longing for the day when they will join us at the Table of the Lord. Now we pray for them in this sacred silence, from our hearts, asking God to protect and to heal them in the weeks remaining before they enter the waters of Baptism and join us for the first time in the Eucharist.

Intercessions for the Elect: The cantor and choir lead us in praying aloud the special prayers for our Elect.

Prayer of Exorcism: The Presider leads us in praying that our catechumens may be freed from the power and influence of the Evil One and protected on their faith-journey. (This is *an ancient prayer for protection!*)

The Laying on of Hands: This silent and powerful ritual also comes from the early days of the church, and also is used in the Sacraments of Confirmation and Ordination. The Presider lays his hands briefly on their heads; then their sponsors, their co-journeymen in The Rite of Christian Initiation, and members of the assembly, are invited join in the laying on of hands. Finally, others present are invited by extending their right hands in blessing, as together we call down the Spirit of Jesus to be with and to protect them.

Presentations: To give further expression of our sharing faith with our Elect and inviting them into the community of faith we present them with the Creed on the Third Sunday and the Our Father on the Fifth Sunday. In this way we symbolize as a community their final preparation – we pass on our beliefs and we unite with them in our relationship with God.

Invitation to the Elect: They are invited to remain for the Eucharistic liturgy, even though they cannot yet receive Communion, and experience the love and support of our praying community.

These Rites originate in a book called the **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults** published by the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops in 1987. The same process is appropriately adapted for younger people and aptly entitled the “**Rite of Christian Initiation of Children of Catechetical Age.**”
