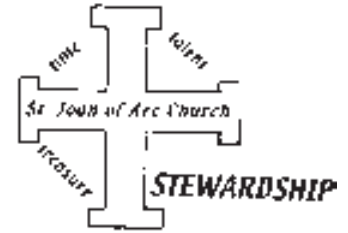

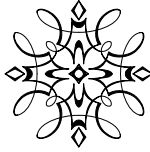

FROM THE DESK OF FR. DAN

Peace and Goodness to all!

Last weekend we celebrated my 25th anniversary of ordination to priesthood. The actual day was the 31st of January. Rosanne Kelly arranged the wonderful dinner celebration in the banquet room of the Canadiana Restaurant at Six Points. It was a lovely gathering of about a hundred people, including members of my family who came up from Buffalo, a couple of fellow friars and many parishioners. Rosanne and volunteers posted old photographs on large posters and Larry O'Grady managed to rig a large screen video of the ordination ceremony in the background that played throughout the evening. I could hardly believe it, who was that young priest with all the curly hair?

The toasts and presentations by John Scali, Fr. Pat Cogan SA and Fr. Damian Mac Pherson SA kept us in stitches and Larry O'Grady who acted as MC did a bit of a roast, and Fr. Damian read letters from Archbishop Collins, Bishop McGrattan, Fr. Timothy MacDonald, the Vicar General of the Atonement Friars, and Mayor Rob Ford. It was quite an honor, but mostly it was a touching experience that made me feel loved and treasured by all in the parish. My sisters and brother in law expressed their great appreciation for the warm and loving welcome they received. They felt right at home. St. Joan of Arc Parish embraced me with a warm hug that I will never forget. Thank you!

I can't begin to express how deeply touched and grateful I am for the heartfelt tribute this brought to me. Once again, Thank you, how could I thank you enough!

Sunday after the 10:00, 12:00 and 7:00 PM masses there were coffee and cake gatherings where so many of you expressed your love and gratitude to me for my service to the parish. It is I who am grateful to Almighty God and to you for making this celebration so profoundly meaningful and appreciated. It is a joy to be able to celebrate the Eucharist in this community at this time in my life and priesthood, because you all represent the Church in such a wonderful, diverse and universal way that expresses beautifully, the Faith Hope and Love of God. It gives me an opportunity to experience the fullness of God's gifts to all like nothing else.

Tonight, at the RCIA gathering we used the video of the Ordination to educate the class about Holy Orders. It was the first time that I had ever been able to closely watch and listen to the ceremony in a way that made me re-live the moments, and remember the people who were present for the event. It was a holy experience. Bishop Trautman's homily recalled the words of Mary's Magnificat to speak of what the priesthood means; "My soul magnifies the Greatness of the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God My Saviour" What came to me is that although am not worthy, "God has done great things for me and Holy is His name".

Being a priest is a gift that God has given me to serve you and I humbly want to thank God and all of you for the privilege it is to be with you. I want also to thank all of you for sharing your lives, your precious time and your many gifts with me and for this parish. May the Love of Jesus and Mary fill you all with Grace and the Joy of Christ forever!
