

FROM THE DESK OF FR. DAN

This afternoon a woman telephoned to say how warmly she has been received by our parish community whenever she comes to celebrate Sunday Mass with us. She asked if she and her family could become parishioners, and of course I told her we would be delighted for her to register her family and become a part of the parish. This was good news to me and a sign of the Love of God that you bring forward to the community.

Tonight the RCIA program members will gather to prepare to receive the Easter Sacraments of Baptism Eucharist and Confirmation.
