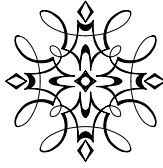

Today we celebrate the feast of the Baptism of the Lord. This event demonstrates the humility of our Lord Jesus, who submitted himself to the ritual of St. John's baptism of repentance and thus transformed it to become the Sacrament of our Salvation in Christ. This day marks the end of the Christmas Season and the beginning of Ordinary time in the liturgical calendar as we shift our focus from the Nativity of the Lord to his public ministry.
