



Peace and Goodness to All!

Today we welcome Bishop William Mc Grattan our regional Auxiliary Bishop as he presides and preaches the Word of God at our Sunday Eucharist Celebrations. At the Noon Mass, the bishop will also celebrate the rite of admission for our 12 participants in the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, the RCIA; and our 4 participants in the Rite of Christian Initiation for Children, the RCIC. We are privileged to serve these aspiring members of our community, and delighted that the Bishop is here in this first formal liturgical step in their program. May the Holy Spirit continue to guide and protect these individuals who walk with us on their spiritual journey toward reception of the Easter Sacraments.

While the Bishop is here he will meet with the staff, and representatives of many of our organizations, he will meet with the finance committee, and the building committees to hear of our material progress, and with the parish council who will inform him of our spiritual progress through the series of retreats that are provided to help us focus on our Mission as a parish and to realize the Kingdom of God as it unfolds in our worship and ministries. We have submitted our Parish Vitality Report to the Archdiocese through Bishop Mc Grattan's office, and we hope his experience in visitation will enable him to see a bit of who we are as a parish. We are so glad that he is with us for this weekend. Please welcome him and make him feel at home.

We also welcome Fr. Timothy MacDonald, SA. The Vicar General of the Franciscan Friars of the Atonement, who has come to be with us during this visitation. Fr. Tim will be familiar to many of you since he served here as an associate pastor for a year while Fr. John Kiesling, SA was pastor. Fr. Tim was also my novice director 30 years ago, and so he is a long time friend of mine (I almost said old friend, but have learned to choose my words more carefully) Fr. Timothy oversees the parishes that are sponsored by the Atonement Friars, and so it will be good for him to see what we are doing to deepen the Charism of our community as we serve this parish in the Archdiocese of Toronto. Fr. Tim is a native of Nova Scotia, and probably is not related to Sir John A. MacDonald, but I could be wrong. At any rate, he is Canadian, and so please welcome him warmly back to his homeland.

I want to express my profound gratitude to all of the members of the various organizations and committees who have been working to prepare for this visitation, and who have made themselves available for the meetings that are being held this weekend. Thank you all.

Once we have completed this process, I will inform you all of the results and feedback we will receive. Thank you all for your generous stewardship of time, talent and substance that contribute to the ongoing life and vitality of our great parish.
