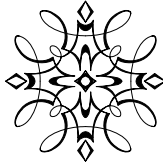

Peace and Goodness to all!

We celebrate the Annual Week of Prayer for Christian unity this week, from January 18 through 25th. This is an especially important time for the Friars of the Atonement because it was established by Fr. Paul Wattson, the founder of our order and been promoted by our community now for over a hundred years.

This Sunday's reading from the letter to the Corinthians reminds us that we are all gifted to serve the One Lord in the Church in a variety of ways for the good of all. The Holy Spirit empowers all of us to use our gifts and here at St. Joan of Arc parish, we do this through our Stewardship programs. Philippines Typhoon Relief

Typhoon Bopha (known locally as "Pablo") passed to the south of the large islands of the Palau archipelago in December, on its way to the Philippines, with winds recorded at over 250 km per hour. The human toll has been catastrophic and continues to rise. In total, more than 5 million people have been affected by the situation, prompting the President of the Philippines, Benigno Aquino, to declare a state of emergency. There is an urgent need to distribute food, shelter, and medicine to the affected population. Thousands of people have fled their homes and are in need of basic necessities. Water scarcity and contamination is also a major problem. Donations can be made to aid those affected. Archdiocesan Relief envelopes are at the entrances of the church. Please make sure you include all your information, so this can be included in your tax receipt. (Be assured: 100% of this collection will go to the aid of the people.)
