Today at Graymoor, Brother Alexander Reed, SA becomes Father Alexander Reed, SA. We rejoice with him in this as he will return to us in his new role as priest! It has been a long journey for him. Aside from the physical distances which brought him here from the Patagonia region of Chile to Graymoor in the United States, he has had a varied and diverse background. He is an OB/GYN doctor and serve this function in his ministry to the poor women in Patagonia. He was ordained an Episcopal priest and part of his ministry brought him to the Chilean Navy as a chaplain. He became an Episcopalian Franciscan while in Chile. His Franciscan community desired to join the Roman Catholic Church and were told to contact us, the Franciscan Friars of the Atonement, as we had done this back in 1909. Since then, other members of his community have become Roman Catholic, joined us, and then were ordained Roman Catholic priests. He loves working in the parish and we are happy to have him. As soon as I know when he will be back, I'll schedule a potluck luncheon for him after the noon Mass. Keep your eyes and ears open for this that we may have a great celebration for him.

This past week religious education has started back up for our children preparing to receive their first communion and for our kids preparing for confirmation. I am grateful that we have adults in the parish who are willing to share their faith with the younger ones. I am also hoping that are confirmation students will become the seeds of our Youth Ministry. During the COVID period, the kids in our Youth Ministry eventually graduated from high school and moved on leaving us a big gap in the parish. We're trying to fill that gap so that all people, young and old, might find a place and something to do at Saint Joan of Arc. We also had an information night about forming a Pastoral Council. As we become more active it's more important for us to stay in touch with the parish as it grows. This is where the Pastoral Council comes in. Aside from bringing in new ideas, they will also help foster and encourage the many existing groups that we already have so that they may continue to grow and work together for the good of all.

Our fledgling Young Adult group met for a night of games and fun and we are hoping for continued growth with them. If you know of any young adults who perhaps aren't coming to church. wish to invite them, not to Mass but rather, to come to our Young Adults. I figure it's better to get them near church rather than not at church at all. We can let God take care of the rest.
