I had a wonderful meeting this past week with the new principal of St. Luigi's school. As you may know we recently took over the pastoral care of the students there. I have been there once for Mass with them, and we were scheduling future Masses and confessions and just some time for me to meet with the kids. Most of them remember me from the Mass I did for them at the beginning of the year, so when we went around the school, they felt pretty comfortable chatting with me. I look forward to meeting with them and seeing them. Many asked if I'd gotten my new dog yet because they wanted to meet her so I asked them to keep praying for the situation that we can be reunited and when we are I'll bring her with me to meet them.

I'm not sure how many of them or the students at Marrocco/Merton high school ever come the Saint Joan of Arc or even go to Mass someplace else but I'm glad to establish a relationship with them. You never know where it may lead and as I learned many years ago the beginning of my ministry - give people a positive experience of church and they may come back. I'm hoping that as they grow, they will find in me and hopefully in the parish a welcoming presence that will lead them to God. They were happy to be involved in our Advent planning this year, and I hope it continues into the future. I know that Marrocco/Merton has a choir and I would love to have them come here to do some concerts. First of all it brings them back into the church again and secondly it would bring many of their parents who may or may not come to church. You know that nagging people to go to church never works. In fact, it sometimes drives people further away. So, bringing people back gently for reasons other than Mass to introduced them to the parish may lead them to come back.

As we move out of the pandemic, it's obvious that there are far fewer parishioners here at Saint Joan of Arc, so we are trying to reach out to new audiences to bring them in. As you know we have plenty of room! Of course, change is never an easy thing. But it is inevitable - the world changes, the church changes, and we change (though sometimes kicking and screaming). We are working on some changes here in the parish, not change for change sake, but rather change for growth. The growth of our parishioners and the growth of our parish. I appreciate your patience during these times and welcome any ideas that you may have that may further our growth. I'm even open to hearing things that will help with my growth as your pastor!

Starting in Lent, you should see some of the changes. We now have an Art & Environment committee that will take over the decorating of the church (which I'm glad to give up). We will be starting up the noon Mass for Lent which means we are looking to re-form the 12:00 o'clock choir. If you are a member, you should have been contacted, if you would like to be a member, we would love to have you so contact us and we will forward your information on to the choir director.


