This past week the Church celebrated the "Week of Prayer for Christian Unity". Each year from January 18 - 25 this octave founded by Servant of God, Fr. Paul Wattson, SA, is observed by Christians of all denominations to gather in the Spirit of Jesus who prayed: "That all may be one" (JN 17:21). Fr. Paul is also the founder of the Franciscan Friars of the Atonement of which we friars are members. Here at St. Joan of Arc we have been observing this through out the week at our masses and in a special Taize prayer gathering on Wed. Evening. This prayer gathering brought members and clergy of our neighbouring Christian denominations to chant, read scriptures and meditate in the beautiful context of the Taize prayer tradition. We were deeply enriched and blessed to host this beautiful event.

This afternoon, at St. James Anglican Cathedral at 106 King Street E. in Toronto, the Annual city-wide celebration of the Week of Prayer will be held at 4:30 PM. Cardinal Collins will be participating along with Bishop Arbil the Anglican bishop and many other clergy members. The faithful of many Christian denominations will participate. You are cordially invited to attend this worship service that is open to all.

As you may notice the work on the carpet replacement has begun and will continue throughout the week.
