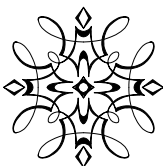

This past week the Church celebrated the “Week of Prayer for Christian Unity”. Each year from January 18 - 25 this octave founded by Servant of God, Fr. Paul Wattson, SA, is observed by Christians of all denominations to gather in the Spirit of Jesus who prayed: “That all may be one” (JN 17:21). Fr. Paul is also the founder of the Franciscan Friars of the Atonement of which we friars are members. Here at St. Joan of Arc we have been observing this through out the week at our masses and in a special Taize prayer gathering on Wed. Evening. This prayer gathering brought members and clergy of our neighbouring Christian denominations to chant, read scriptures and meditate in the beautiful context of the Taize prayer tradition.
