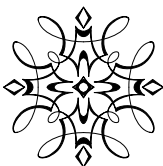

THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to all!

Please look around the Church today and notice the new Exit signs that have been installed. Our Building Maintenance Committee has worked to find the most appropriate and inconspicuous signs available that will meet the safety need of the parish community. This committee has continued to meet bi-weekly to address the many issues that are important for the upkeep and improvement of our facilities. This week we also went ahead to have a qualified carpenter order the materials to complete the storage cabinets in our meeting room to build the storage compartments for our various organizational needs. We expect that by the end of the summer we will have the storage compartments that each group has asked us to provide. It has been a long process to discover these needs and then to consider where best to build these for the convenience and practicalities involved. The building committee has identified many needs that will be met over time as urgency and budget issues dictate. The Finance Committee will provide a bulletin insert in the coming week to outline the ways and means the community is providing to cover the costs in the most responsible way.

One thing that was identified some months ago which is not in the urgent category is the need for a new sign to replace the one on the front wall of the church that is quite old and worn. I have been speaking with a local sign designer to give us some ideas with the costs involved. You will see in the bulletin that my goal for this year's Ironman Swim, Bike and Run at Lake Placid is to raise funds to pay for the new sign. Just as last year we installed the new Bells, and the year before we fixed the Stained Glass windows, the sign will be a tangible enhancement that we can point to and acknowledge with a plaque to the contributors of the Iron Friar Campaign. We had also considered the possibility of putting light on the Church Tower, but will continue to think about this because of such issues as light pollution etc. that may impinge on the value of lighting the tower. The need for a new sign however is something that will practically enhance our appearance and make us a bit more visible for people to know we are here and what our service schedules happen to be throughout the year.

During the summer most of our weekly meetings are suspended, but a few of us will be meeting regularly to map out the strategies for the upcoming Stewardship Weekend in September and to prepare our Parish photos for the Album that will be completed in October. Some of the Choirs will take a breather in the summer also, but there will continue to be musicians to lead us in song for the liturgies. I would like once again to express my sincere thanks to all of you for your generosity in providing for the needs of the parish, and my gratitude to all who continue to work behind the scenes to complete the plans and tasks that are set before us and that we continue to develop. Thank you all for your prayerful dedication to God and this house of worship.

May God Bless you, all abundantly with some rest and leisure during these summer months.

**Annual Mass for the Faithful Departed**

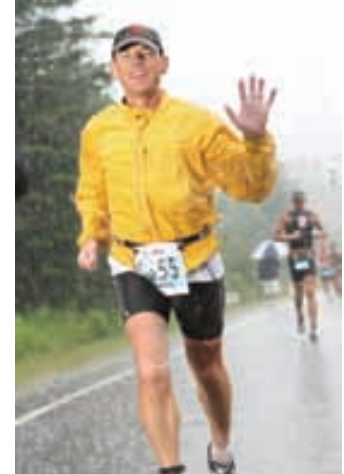

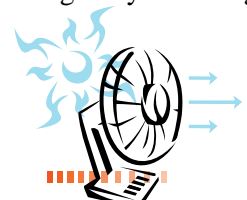
