#### THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and All Good to you and your loved ones.

Each week at St. Joan of Arc our liturgical celebrations are preceded with the Stewardship Prayer. In this we thank God for our many gifts of relationship, and the spiritual and material resources we have to build and strengthen these. Each week we ask God's help and strength to become better followers in the footsteps of Jesus, as his disciples and members of the Christian Community here at St. Joan of Arc Parish.

Yesterday, Cathi Richardson our new resource consultant for Parish Stewardship and I began our planning to strengthen the structures for stewardship in our parish organizations. Cathi has begun to analyze the strengths and limitations in our present structures so that we can be better poised to build on our strengths in preparation for renewing our individual and communal commitments when we celebrate Stewardship weekend in September. We have decided to outline the various ways in which individuals participate in the life of the parish so that each parishioner will be able to identify the best way to become involved in the life and work of the parish.

Rose DiTommaso, as head of the Stewardship Committee will continue to coordinate this weekend and the organization of the material it generates. Cathi will be working behind the scenes to prepare the ground for a robust response and full engagement to the committees that are represented in the Stewardship of our parish. This work has begun in the current analysis, and Cathi will be contacting the leaders of the current organizations to lend support in growing each one.

We hope to arrange the various tasks, duties and responsibilities for these organizations according to the time and abilities that are required, so that individuals can involve themselves generously to the extent that is possible for them, given the requirements of the organizations and the structural and time limitations that exist in the life of individuals and families of its members.

Some involvements entail one time commitments and duties for a particular event. Others might involve weekly or monthly engagements, as liturgical ministers or as Sunday school teachers. Still others involve occasional service in committees or organizations that arise as for example in providing service to Winter Welcome Table or the Funeral receptions that occur occasionally. Some are seasonal as the gardening committee. Still others require the specialized skills necessary for such things as the finance or building committees which are ongoing and require planning for succession of members on a rotating basis. Parish council members represent various organizations for reporting to the parish.

The purpose of this planning process is to permit individuals to know what they are committing to, and to be aware of when their commitments begin and end in a predictable and manageable way. It is our hope that in this you will all discover the best way for you to become involved in the life and work of the parish that God is calling us all to serve as Stewards.

Throughout the summer we will be addressing the progress of our plans as we aim for the Stewardship sign up weekend. If you have any questions about this please don't hesitate to ask me or Cathi. We are wide open to suggestions and information that will help us to invigorate the Spirit of Stewardship that is the hallmark of this vibrant and wonderful parish.

Please keep these efforts in your prayers and consider how God is calling you to become involved in the life and work of our Parish. May the Holy Spirit guide us as we continue in the Way of the Lord who is our Shepherd and Guide.
