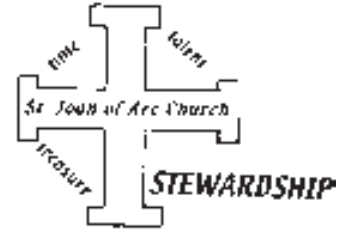

Peace and Goodness to All!

This week the Sunday scripture readings all converge on the theme of God's proximity to us in being human. Moses speaks of God's presence among us, and Paul tells us that Jesus is the image of the invisible God. Jesus in the Gospel takes this theme one step closer in describing the Kingdom of God being manifest in the actions of the Good Samaritan to help us understand our participation in the kingdom by our loving our neighbor. Who is our neighbor is described in the care of a stranger and foreigner by the generous attention delivered by the Good Samaritan to the man who was victimized by thieves. This theme is a challenge to each of us to examine our attitudes and the criteria of our decisions in recognizing all people as our neighbors as we consider that we are commanded to love our neighbor as ourselves.

Our parish mission of proclaiming and living the gospel through stewardship extends itself to fulfill this commandment as we express and realize that "all are welcome." As I look around the church each week, I am always gratified to see new people in our midst and edified to hear that these people feel welcomed and embraced by the community. Not a week goes by that I do not hear someone new express the fact that they have felt welcomed when they came here to worship the Lord. Thank you to all of you as you, reach out to greet and welcome new people and continue to build fellowship within the community. A special word of thanks to our Greeting committee members who embrace all who enter to worship. May the Holy Spirit continue to inspire us to live the Gospel mandate to Love God and our neighbor with all our hearts!

Vincent for covering the masses while I was away, and to the parish staff for their presence and support.
