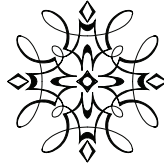

I don't know about you, but I'm really tired of this Corona virus! I would love to get back to normal life, to be able to travel freely, to shake hands and to hug others when I greet them, but I can't do it yet. Our online Mass is continuing to grow. Members of the 10:00 o'clock choir are working behind the scenes to provide music for us. I'd like to thank them for all the work that's involved in compiling the music, editing it, and then sending it to me for use on Sunday at Mass.

Last week Barry Carolyn and I ran the wires for the new camera. I had already installed an electrical outlet for it and now we simply wait for it to arrive. This should improve our live streaming of Mass on Sunday, as it won't be just a fixed camera. We will be able to zoom in on the altar during the eucharistic prayer, focus on the ambo during the readings, and even focus on the baptismal font when we are having baptisms so that our babies can be stars! Of course, this is going to mean that I need to learn How to use the software to control it, but it doesn't look that difficult.

This week I have been working at cleaning out the sacristy, and the closets within. You could barely move in the storage room with all the stuff that was in there. Now there are empty shelves and open floor space! I discovered in the cabinets, things that date back to the Sacred Heart Fathers. And some things that were being saved for the missions by Sr. Elizabeth, who was here years ago, but never got sent out. Suffice to say that when I'm done, we will know what we have and where it is. I was hoping, before the shutdown, to get an Art and Environment Committee together for the church. They would be responsible for the seasonal decor in the church. I'm still hoping to start this group and I'm willing to provide some training to any who may be interested.

Something our Stewardship Committee did, was to take over the control of our website. So shortly you should start to begin to see some changes. It would be extremely helpful if we had anyone with skills and talents along those lines to give us a hand. If you're out there in the parish or if you know someone in the parish who perhaps doesn't read this, but it has web skills, please pass along this request. We may be even looking to hire someone part time.

I heard from Bishop Kasun, and he said that some parishes are putting off Confirmation until next year. I'm hoping that we can do Confirmation sometime this fall, if we can fit everyone into the church. Perhaps we can use the Hall for overflow, and of course we would live stream it to those who couldn't attend. We'll see what September brings.

I thank you for your messages to me during Mass and Bible Study, I read each one when I'm done, and they give me strength and joy. Stay safe and well,
