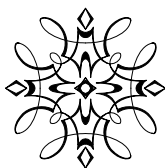

2014 Iron Man

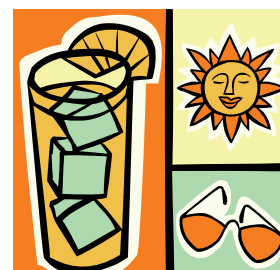
