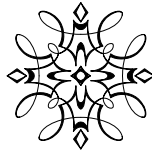

As you read this I will be engaged in the Ironman USA Lake Placid competition for the 13th year running. On Saturday evening at the time of our vigil mass, I am scheduled to celebrate the “Iron Mass” at St. Agnes Church in Lake Placid. The race itself begins at 7:00 AM with a massive start in Mirror Lake, where close to 3000 will begin the 4.4 k swim, followed by the 180 k bicycle through the mountains followed by the 42.2 K marathon. Please accept my heartfelt thanks for your prayerful support and your donations to the Iron Friar campaign for the new Church Signs. Your support is what sustains everything that I can do.

This week, Cathi Richardson and I met to talk about our plans for stewardship weekend and the various priorities for the coming year. Larry and Cyndi O’Grady met earlier to draw from the AGM, Parish Council and Staff meetings of the past year so we could identify our priorities. We are looking forward to gathering the parish organizing committees and organizations for a blessed and fruitful season. With your prayers and participation, it will be a good year for our spiritual growth and development.

Besides the various retreats and committee activities that have been scheduled, the completion of our Parish Directory and other administrative tasks to deal with we have identified a couple of immediate needs for the parish. We hope to put these into place as soon as possible to facilitate organizing our internal and external communication capacities. Our Communication Committee and Finance Committees have both recommended that we do a thorough assessment and implementation of a computer system for our offices that is functional and interactive.

We are looking to see if there are any parishioners who would might be connected with a “Geek Squad” type organization, with whom we might contract to do this work in a timely and professional fashion. If no one from the parish comes forward we will seek outside contractors to do it soon. If you can recommend an experienced and qualified outfit to help us in this endeavour, please contact the parish office so we can complete this project as soon as possible.

Cathi will also be approaching individuals to help us to renovate our Website so that it can be managed in a timely and efficient manner. We will continue to engage our Communication Committee members once the systems are in place. Our telephone system contract is also about to expire and so we will look to see if we can create a synergy among all of our telecommunications equipment to improve our efficiencies in all areas of telephone and computer technologies.

Our efforts to welcome people, communicate the Gospel and gather at the table of the Lord are all important parts of the parish mission that unite all of our parish organizations as we continue as Stewards of our Gifts. Having the proper tools to do the work that God gives us will make our work more effective and our outreach to all, better served. Please pray that God will bless the work of our hearts and hands.

This week we welcome the visiting priests who are here to serve the community. I know they will be welcomed by the warmth and love of all. I am grateful for their presence and service during these few days of my absence.

Thank you again for your prayerful love and support, I hope to bring back a medal to show you next week at the masses.
