Some parishes do not have the financial capacity to preserve these historic sacred spaces and we have the responsibility to ensure their maintenance for years to come. We also want to continue to the growth that has been happening in the Archdiocese of Toronto. Fourteen churches have been constructed and opened since 2000. Our growing family of faith means we expect this pattern continue. The cost of new churches continues to rise and this campaign will help provide for those costs by providing new parishes an opportunity for financing through the archdiocese, allowing them to begin construction earlier in the process.
