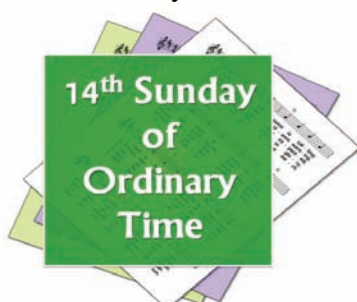

It really is nice to get back to celebrating Mass without having to worry about all the other technical things. Although I was so excited this past weekend that I forgot to start the live stream on time. Sorry, mea culpa! I'll try to do better.

I wasn't sure if anyone would notice but I was wrong because I heard a variety of compliments on the candle rings that I made this past week. I was thinking but the sanctuary looked a little stark and now that Michaels is open, I went to get supplies to make candle rings. In the fall I plan to change them to autumnal colours and maybe in the winter some small wreaths. It just adds a little something during Ordinary Time when we don't have a lot of decoration going on. And it's fun because I get to do some arts and crafts. (And it keeps me out of trouble.)

Regarding losing this long beard, I plan to raffle the option to cut it off and will do it as soon as we can use the Parish Hall. Be on the lookout for raffle tickets going on sale. However, the winner is only allowed to cut the beard - not my throat!
