

#### 2012 Mission Appeal

On the weekend of August 11& 12<sup>th</sup>, we will have Fr. John Pullumarykunnel visiting us. He is being sent by his Bishop Thomas Pulloppillil, bishop of Bongaigaon, Assam, India, which is in the north east of India,

His diocese has 31 schools and 50 hostels for boys and girls. The diocese was erected in 2000, starting with 46,000 Catholics, 24 priests, 14 parishes and 78 nuns. They have grown to 65,000 Catholics, 50 priests, 25 parishes and 130 nuns. They are engaged in educational and healthcare activities as well relief and other developmental activities like formation of self help groups.

Fr. John will be coming to ask us for our prayers and financial support for his diocese, so they can concentrate on educating the marginalized, and hope to help those who have no means to continue their studies. Beneficiaries of this project will be the economically poor and bright students of the seven districts of Assam in the diocese of Bongaigaon.

We will have envelopes available for this special collection.
