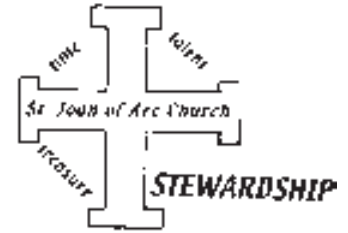

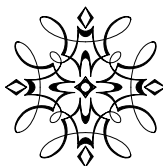

This past Tuesday, we had our Annual General Meeting where stewards of our organizations and committees recounted the accomplishments of the past year and set forth their goals for the coming season. We are deeply blessed to have so many dedicated volunteers who continue the ministry of our parish as stewards of the Kingdom.

One interesting highlight outlined the emerging Ministries Committee in their plans to engage the parish in a survey to discover the ways we can best grow and utilize our resources for ministry in the present and future. Many Thanks go out to Louis and all who are engaged in these outreach ministries of our parishes and ecumenical/interfaith communities.

We have received news that our parish album and pictorial directory will be delivered on July 19th. This effort by Larry and Cyndi O’Grady and Cathi Richardson is greatly appreciated. Thank you to all of you who participated in this project and thank you for your patience we hope you will enjoy the final product.

This year I will once again run the Ironman as a fundraiser for the parish, we hope to install a retractable stage in the hall to help with public speaking engagements and enhance worship that may be conducted there in the case of overflow crowds. The Building Committee is looking into the installation and cost of the venture.

This week on Wednesday we had the new security system installed. This will permit surveillance of the property and improved alarms for the Church and Friary, at a reduced monthly cost. Thank you to the building committee and especially Larry O’Grady for negotiating this with ADT. Great work Larry.

Wednesday evening the CWL hosted the tri-monthly blood drive. Once again we wish to say thank you to all who give the gift of life through blood donations. Thanks also to the CWL and especially Clare Sands who stepped in for Yolanda Russo who was out of town for this session. The CWL is a great blessing to our parish, and we are grateful for all of their dedicated and prayerful service.

Thank you to all of you who continue to serve to plant the seed of God’s word and service throughout the parish life and ministries. May God continue to multiply the work of our hands! Let us pray that God will continue to send laborers into this field at St. Joan of Arc so we may become the place of hospitality and welcome to all who seek the Kingdom of God in our midst.

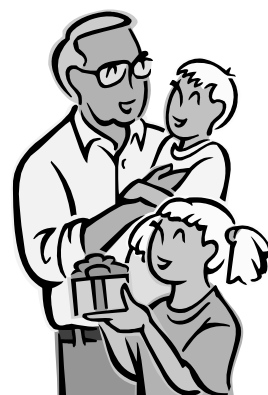
