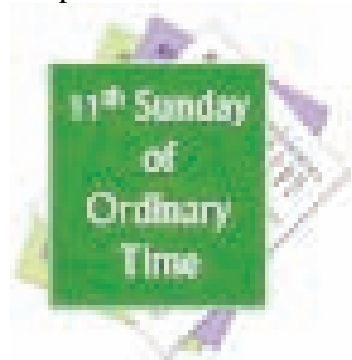

When I first recognized that God was calling me to this life, the biggest disappointment for me was that I would never be a father. I had become an uncle at the age of 13 and thought it was the neatest thing in the world, so I couldn't wait to become a dad and have my own kids. But I felt that God had other plans for me.

I have learned in the intervening years that being a dad doesn't simply mean you have children that are related to you but rather you get to show fatherly care to others. I remember last year when I had to put Sonia down because of her cancer, I cried wondering or not if I had been a good enough dog dad. As it was, she was easy to be a dad to because of her calm demeanor and easygoing way. Now I'm being tested by Bodhi who, like most people with more than one child discover, is very different from his older sister. We're still working together to make him "a better dog". And luckily, I have seen some progress with him.

This past week I got to flex my dad credentials once again at the grocery store. I stopped on the way out at the Starbucks and there were four children in front of me, elementary school aged, who were trying to decide what they wanted and asking what was in each various drink. I waited patiently as I didn't have any place to rush to and after all it was only a cup of coffee. When they finally ordered, it was a girl and three boys, the girl asked the cashier if they had any "extra cake pops" that they wanted to get rid of. The barista and I both tried not laughing and she said "no I'm afraid not." Then the young girl asked if there were any other baked goods that might be "extra" was disappointed to hear that there were no extra baked goods that were giving out for free.

When I placed my order, I told the barista to add four cake pops to my order for these kids. So, the cashier asks them "What kind of cake pops do you want?" They were quite surprised, and I told them it was on me, so enjoy them, not knowing that's selecting cake pops would be almost as difficult for them as selecting a beverage. But they got their cake pops and were very gracious and thanked me and when the girl behind the counter rang my order up and didn't charge me for my coffee! I told her "How often do you have the chance to do something nice for someone as easy as this?" If we think of it there are opportunities in our lives to share our good fortune and bring happiness to others and we should seize on them.

Last weekend, members of the building committee and volunteers worked to clean up and plant the gardens around the outside of the church and to do some painting. I hope you have noticed the difference - they certainly made me a proud Papa. We also celebrated our Saint Joan of Arc feast day with a delightful brunch on Sunday and I was thrilled with the volunteers and the people who came and shared.
