

PEACE AND GOODNESS TO ALL!

Today we celebrate St. Joan of Arc Day, on the Sunday closest to the feast which is May 30th. It is a day to enjoy our faith community at a picnic. This has been a long tradition here in the parish with many memories of gathering in High Park, the Marocco Merton athletic field and in recent years here in our own parking area and parish hall. Much thanks to Wanda Brown, Nellie Burrows and their many assistants for organizing the event this year. Thanks also to Stephanie Ficker and Cathi Richardson, previous leaders who shared their experience and expertise to make this a grand success. There will be added features this year including a photo booth to capture memories. The Lord has blessed our parish family in so many ways and we give thanks and praise for God's loving kindness.

Today is also the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, the day when the Church throughout the world celebrates the Eucharist as the Source and Summit of our Life and worship. What a blessing this parish is to me, and I am grateful to God and to all of you who make my service here a joy and a pleasure. Thank you to all of you who make St. Joan of Arc a vibrant reflection of God's love, service and hospitality to all. Let's have fun today and give thanks to the Lord who is so good to us.
