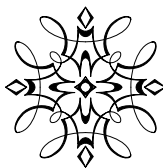

THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to all!

This past Tuesday St. Joan of Arc Parish held our Annual General Meeting. This is our yearly opportunity for some twenty nine of our various group leaders to report on the activities that have gone on in the stewardship of our parish. It also sets forth the goals and objectives of each committee or group for the next year. The published report will be made available to the website, or if you would like a printed copy you can receive one at the parish office.

It is always gratifying to see the wonderful work that is done through the stewardship efforts of so many dedicated individuals who cooperate to make St. Joan of Arc Parish the lively and welcoming place that it is. As your pastor, I want to say Thank you to all who accomplish the great ministry and work of the Lord as you serve the parish efforts. It is not possible to recount all of the highlights here, so I hope you will read the report to see for yourselves the great things being done by so many loving volunteers here in our parish.

After the reports we recalled the parish structures that are developing to organize these groups that report to the parish through the parish council. This is continuing in its formation process. This summer, Larry O'Grady Cathi Richardson, John Scali and I will be working to re visit the by-laws of the parish council so they are appropriate to the structures we currently utilize. Larry has been the Chair person for six years and so perhaps by this time next year we will be ready to hold the appropriate elections for a new parish Chairman in keeping with the rotation schedules that affirm our commitment to ongoing leadership development. We also are considering a Ministry Committee composed of ministry professionals who can guide our pastoral and ministerial development as a parish. More will be said on this as it develops. We are currently seeking resumes of persons with needed expertise for this committee.

Larry had his camera available at the AGM to take pictures of some of the groups, I have some pictures in the computer, and we will take others in the summer and autumn so the group and activity pages of our new parish directory will be completed in the fall. We have established the dates of September 30 – October 2 to take individual and family photos to accommodate those families who were unable to have their pictures taken this spring. We look forward to having a beautiful representation of our parish in this album.

One aspect of our parish life that was reported on last night that has expanded is our commitment to the Ecumenical Character of the parish. Three examples were cited: The "Stroll Thru Scripture" program held by Sr. Elizabeth is doing a new outreach to other Christians in the area to participate in these afternoon sessions. On St. Joan of Arc Day, Pastor Eric from the Lutheran Church next door and I blessed the shared property of their Church and ours that are set aside to grow vegetables for various charitable pantry and meal providing programs for the less fortunate. Last year we held an Ecumenical Advent Lessons and Carols at Christmas time and we are planning to expand upon this for the coming year. These are in addition to the Week of Prayer which we always celebrate in January. As most of you know the ministry of the Friars of the Atonement is particularly dedicated to pray and work for the unity of Christians, and so these efforts are in keeping with this important ministry.

This weekend at all of the Masses, Cathi Richardson, our Stewardship coordinating consultant will express our gratitude to our Stewards and remind us of the next Stewardship weekend to be held in September. While many of the parish activities slow down a bit during the summer months, it is a good time for us to map out the course for the coming year. May the Lord bless us in our efforts.

For many this summer will be a time of relaxation and refreshment and I pray that all of us will be able to find blessing in leisure time to know God's love and healing for the busy season that always follows summer.

RCIA: The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

RCIA is the usual way by which an unbaptized adult becomes a full, participating member of the Catholic Church is through a faith formation process call the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)*, or for children over the age of seven years *The Rite of Christian Initiation of Children (RCIC)*. The reception of the sacraments is usually at the Easter Vigil. Persons that have been baptized in another Christian Church and who wish to explore the Catholic faith are also encouraged to enrol in the RCIA programme. By participating in the programme they prepare themselves for the sacraments of Confirmation and the Eucharist.

If you or someone you know is considering the Catholic Church, contact Fr. Dan, through the parish office and for the RCIC programme contact Sheila Malloch. Like all other programmes, the RCIA & RCIC will start up again in the fall.
