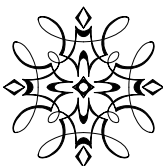

**The Pastor's Corner**  
**Peace and Goodness to All!**

The scripture readings today speak of Christian freedom which is a freedom to love one another as Jesus has taught us, "Love one another as I have loved you". This is a freedom for loving one another in serving the responsibilities we have as members of families, persons dedicated to professions, or responsible in our jobs, committed to worthwhile projects. Certainly here at St. Joan of Arc, we speak of Stewardship of our time talent and treasure as a means of serving God and the Church that proclaims the Gospel and creates an atmosphere of Welcome for others. This Tuesday evening the Ministries committee met to complete this seasons agenda and look forward to our coming together again in September. The members of this committee are instrumental in creating the context for the Stewardship of our parish and I am deeply grateful to each of them for the dedicated and professional service they devote to our parish. This committee is responsible for all of our stewardship oversight. This committee is an advisory committee that assists me and Ana Da Costa in the pastoral oversight of so many volunteers.

On Tuesday it was explained that the music ministry with the exception of the 10 O'clock Choir is managed by Michael Thibodeau and Antione Pellerin. This is because the professional expertise and remunerations involved here are not voluntary but paid positions. (with the exception of the Noon Choir members) This is the last week that our Choirs will be singing for the season and we thank them for their blessed service to the parish and will of course miss them until their return in September. In the mean time there will be musicians filling in for the various masses, and we are grateful to Michael Thibodeau and Antione Pellerin who coordinate the temporary fill in musicians for the summer and in situations like when Dan Godin left his position at the 8:30 Mass. Filling that position has taken a while and has required many interviews and rehearsals. These have been conducted by Michael who is a PhD. candidate in music and took over from Chris McConnell, who was also had a PhD. and was a professor at U of T. He wrote in an email today: "Antoine and I concluded our search for a new pianist/organist this past weekend. In total, there were five applications submitted. Of these, three met the credential and experience requirements and two were invited for interviews. The best choice was evident, and the successful candidate has accepted our invitation to join the team. I am very happy to welcome another music professional to St. Joan of Arc's music ministry - welcome, Brie-Anne!. Brie-Anne Meyer currently plays for St. Joseph's Parish (Streetsville) and St. Benedict's Parish (Etobicoke) on Sunday mornings. In addition to being fluent on the organ, she holds undergraduate (Western) and graduate (University of Ottawa) degrees in piano, and an associate diploma from the Royal Conservatory. Brie Anne will compliment Kyla Cook, who was also recently brought on board through a search process. On Wednesday, the staff gathered all day to set our calendar for next year's agenda. It is a task that requires much consideration of so many factors to make the schedule work effectively. Thank you to all of the various organization members who contribute to the creation of this calendar, it is a pathway that makes our activities possible.
