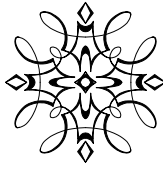

Throughout the world, this week Christians of many denominations, gather to enter into the desert experience of Lent to pray, fast and give alms in gestures of repentance and conversion of heart to prepare to celebrate the Pascal mysteries at Easter. We remember in these 40 days that Jesus himself fasted and prayed before beginning his public life of ministry and service. In the experience He was tested by the devil only to rebuke these temptations with the words of Scripture that were appropriate to the tests. The whole Lenten experience is one that helps us to remember the primacy of God in our lives and to seek a way of life that will draw us ever closer to God and to others.
