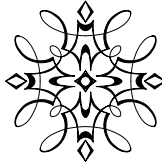

THE PASTOR’S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to all!

Today, the 4th Sunday of Lent was traditionally called Laetare Sunday, a day when we may wear Rose colored vestments to signify our progress through the Lenten season. Here at St. Joan of Arc parish we are using the lectionary readings from Cycle A for the 3rd 4th and 5th Sundays of Lent instead of cycle B. This is called for because we are engaging in the Scrutinies from the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, (RCIA) which calls for the Cycle A readings. Since this program impacts the entire parish, we pray together for our candidates and share in the process as a community. This week we will contemplate the story from John’s gospel of the man born blind who received his sight. The second reading from Ephesians reminds us that we live in the Light of the Lord. This enlightenment also points to the liturgical themes and the brighter colored vestments are involved. The opening prayer or collect for the mass speaks of an increase of spiritual joy. Laetare means to rejoice and so we do, for the Lord is our Shepherd to guide in our Lenten journey.

This week, I was scheduled to attend the Priest’s day of recollection but now making up for interruptions from last week’s storms, I will be attending General Council meetings at Graymoor. There we will be discussing replacements for Fr. Mon who continues to be in our prayers as he continues in hospice. While it was not possible to attend the priest’s day of recollection, the parish day of recollection is coming soon. This past weekend the leaders of our two Choirs began talking about co-ordinations that will take place for our Easter triduum liturgies. It is only a couple of weeks away and so our plans for passion Sunday and Easter are underway. Please remember that our Parish Ministries Retreat will be on Saturday morning March 24th. This day begins at 10:00 and will also have the sheets available to sign up for ministerial positions at the various masses. Please remember to schedule this important day of prayer and reflection as well as ministerial preparation.

On the evening of March 24, we will celebrate Lenten Soup night, the evening when we are invited to collect the alms that we have gathered in our Lenten prayer and fasting exercises, so we may submit a generous donation to Winter Welcome Table, covering the costs for the outreach to the poor that we sponsor with St. Peter’s parish. This day of recollection and our Lenten soup night provide an opportunity to gather as the Lenten season comes to an end, so we may truly celebrate the pascal feasts and Easter Joy.

MERRYMAKERS’ Mass & LUNCH

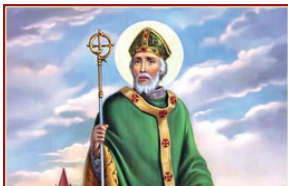
