The Pastor's Corner Peace and Goodness to All!

The Fifth Sunday in Lent marks the beginning of what was traditionally called Passiontide. Before the changes since Vatican II, this Sunday would have been referred to as Passion Sunday, the week before Palm Sunday. Now, Palm Sunday is also called Passion Sunday because it begins the Holy Week celebrations with the reading of the Passion Narratives from on of the three Synoptic Gospels. This year we will be reading from the Gospel of Luke on Palm Sunday. The tradition of covering all of the Statues with Purple Cloth as a sign of increased focus on the central mysteries of the death and Resurrection of Christ. It was practice that was helpful in preparation for the celebration of the Pascal Mysteries in the Easter Triduum. That is Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter. To this day we retain some of these practices here at St. Joan of Arc. Parish. The Baptismal Fount will be covered with Purple cloth, the Statues will all be removed from the walls, and the Cross will be covered with a purple drape. The main altar will have a different purple cloth on its surface, and the symbolic Lenten desert will be removed from the front of the Altar as we contemplate coming closer to Holy Week and Easter.

From Palm Sunday through Easter the décor will change several times as we move through Holy Week, beginning with Holy Thursday with the simple white decoration and the preparation of the altar of repose for the adoration of the Eucharist after Holy Thursday Mass. This will then be totally dismantled for Good Friday when the altar will be decorated Red for the service. After the Good Friday service, the church will be stripped bare again until Easter Saturday when we will bring in the Flowers for decoration in celebration of the Greatest feast of the year. This year we are greatly blessed to have a new Liturgical Arts committee who is learning the ropes and beginning to do the work of decoration for future celebrations. We are grateful to Genevieve, Monique and Cyndy for their artful contributions to this effort. I also thank William who takes down the statues for their annual cleaning and puts up the high purple cloths. God bless the work of their hands.

As we enter these closing weeks of our Lenten journey, let us ask the Holy Spirit to open our hearts to truly celebrate the redemption won for us by the Love of God in Jesus Christ our Saviour. Let us enter this time of contemplation with joy and thanksgiving as we anticipate the Easter Joy that will by his grace be ours.
