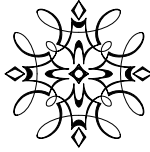

Habemus Papem! His name is Francis. This good news for the Church throughout the world seems to herald that the new pope will look to St. Francis of Assisi as a patron for grace and renewal in the Church. The plans and resources for this activity are well outlined in documents and there is plenty of volunteer help delivered to make this the wonderful family day it is. Today we enter Passion Week. You will notice the statues have been removed and we have covered the baptistery with purple cloth to reflect the prayerful mood of this time as we grow closer to the celebration of the passion of Our Lord and the Paschal Feast. Let us pray that this will truly be a time of renewal for both our parish and the Church throughout the world as we begin again under the leadership of our new Pope Francis.

Let us pray for the new Pope and for the New Life in the Church that comes in the celebration of the Death and Resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ our life and Redeemer!
